Mayor James Hahn will bring a message of solidarity on behalf of the people of Los Angeles.

Among the invited speakers will be North Korean defectors and escapees who will provide first-person testimony to the horrors that the people of North Korea are subjected to.

The conference will include a screening of the controversial BBC documentary, *Access to Evil*, which presents eyewitness accounts of an alleged functioning gas chamber in the North Korean gulag, presented for the first time on the West Coast.
